DEGREE PROGRAMS

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN NURSING ADULT GERONTOLOGY ACUTE CARE NURSE PRACTITIONER (FULLY ONLINE)

- Prepares BSN-holding RNs to become Nurse Practitioners
- Emphasizes Adult/Gerontology Acute Care, which covers a broad base, from young adult to geriatric
- Covers management skills and Six Sigma principles in the advanced practice nursing and healthcare environment
- Requires 43 hours of graduate coursework + 630 clinical practice hours; faculty work with students to find nearby sites where they can accumulate the required clinical hours

POST-MASTER'S CERTIFICATE IN ADULT GERONTOLOGY ACUTE CARE NURSE PRACTITIONER (FULLY ONLINE)

- Suitable for Advanced Practice Registered Nurses (APRN) who are certified in other population foci to receive the necessary professional skills and knowledge to sit for AGACNP certification
- Requires 19 hours of graduate coursework

PRE-LICENSURE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING

- Providing a foundation for professional nursing practice
- Prepare graduates for NCLEX licensure examination
- Completion in 4 semesters once core courses are complete

RN TO BSN COMPLETION PROGRAM (FULLY ONLINE)

- Serves as a pathway for working RNs to complete a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree
- Builds on the knowledge base and clinical expertise of RNs who entered the field through an associate degree or diploma program
- Provides a foundation for graduate education in research, consulting, teaching or a clinical specialization
- Completion in 3 semesters once core courses are done
- Cohorts begin in both Fall and Spring semesters

ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE IN NURSING

- Combines nursing and general education courses
- Prepares graduates for NCLEX licensure examination
- Completion in 4 semesters once core courses are done
