If you are undecided about your academic major or just want to be sure about the one you have declared, the CCLD is here to help you learn more about your options in relation to careers. You can use the information in this handout to begin the exploration process. After visiting the list of majors, learning more about programs, and taking Focus 2, we recommend scheduling a virtual or in-person appointment with a CCLD Career Advisor.

Step 1. Take the FREE Focus 2 Career Assessment - Work Interest, Personality, Skills, Values, and Leisure Interest

Complete 5 assessments: Work Interest, Personality, Skills, Values, and Leisure Interests. It takes approximately
5 minutes to complete each one and learn how you match with MGA majors as well as possible careers.

How to find Focus 2: Scan the QR Code with the camera on your phone or go to www.mga.edu/careerplanningresources and select the "Focus 2 Career Assessment" link at the top of the page.



How to create an account and log into FOCUS 2: After clicking on the Focus 2 Career Assessment link, you'll select the link "First Time Users - Self- Register Here." Use your MGA email address as your username. Login with the access code: knights.

Step 2. Combine all 5 assessments in Focus 2 to see a list of occupations. Click on occupations that interest you, read about them, and save any of your favorites to your Focus 2 profile so you can access later.

You can search for any occupation in the "Explore the Possibilities" section to view job duties, job outlook, salary information, related areas of study, and how the occupation matches your Holland Work Interest Code.
