

The **Dual Enrollment** program provides opportunities for eligible students in grades 9-12 to enroll part- or full-time in postsecondary institutions and take college courses to earn both high school and college credit. Effective July 1, 2015, the Dual Enrollment program combined all previous Georgia dual-credit programs into one program.

Students interested in participating in the Dual Enrollment program must complete the following steps:

1. Complete and submit a Middle Georgia State **Application for Admission** online at GAFutures.org
2. Complete and submit this **Dual Enrollment Participation Agreement**. This agreement must be signed by the student, a parent/guardian, and the student's high school guidance counselor.
3. Register for classes
4. Complete funding application online at GAFutures.org
