The goal of tracking distinct SLOs in each concentration was a good idea in theory, but the numbers divided by campus <i>and</i> concentration tend to be too small to be of significant value. Our departmental Assessment Committee will in 2022-2023 work to reduce the number of SLO's, ideally with a single Learning Outcome that applies effectively across concentrations.
