Optional Open Text Box For Assessment Comments:	Prior Cycle Initiative (SLO 2): A strategy of providing students with additional written assignments in order to create increased opportunities for feedback will be implemented for HIST 2112. This strategy led to an increase in the SLO 2 success rate from 70% to 85%. New Cycle Initiative (SLO 4): SLO 4 witnessed our lowest rate of success. To address this, students will be provided more targeted feedback on written assignments, and be given at least one written assignment in the first three weeks of the course. COMMENT: The B.A. in History has recently added an additional concentration (Public History) on the Macon campus. Revised SLOs that can be used to assess all the concentrations are being generated by the History Assessment Committee . Majors in these concentrations have not yet progressed into the courses where these SLOs will be measured. As History majors progress into these concentrations, assessment of concentrations will be reported.
