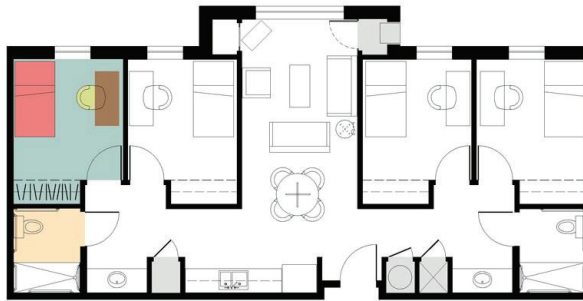
Middle Georgia State places the highest priority on campus safety. The University's own POST-certified police officers are on all campuses.



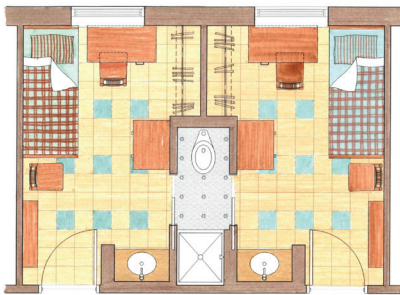

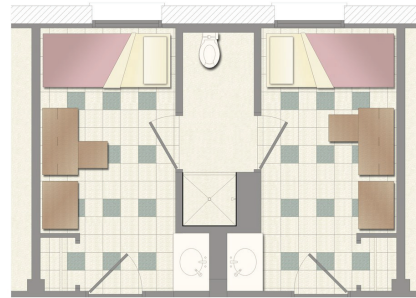
