



SoAL presented 140 events across MGA's campuses. Highlights include:



Poetry reading with 23rd U.S. Poet Laureate Joy Harjo. Total **attendance was over 500**, including K-12 groups.



The 2024 Undergraduate Conference, sponsored by SoAL. **78 MGA students** participated in the conference.



¡Fiesta Flamenca! Across Middle Georgia was presented on three MGA campuses to **over 150 attendees** through the support of the Georgia Council for the Arts via the **Vibrant Communities grant**.



The 2024 Reel People Arts Festival, presented in partnership with **the Douglass Theatre** and with support from the **Linda Harriet Lane Fund**, featured a discussion with *Transformers* composer **Jongnic Bontemps**.

MCA and History students partnered with the 21st Century Partnership to research and produce a documentary about the group.

History partnered with the **Museum of Aviation** to catalog the archive of the 483rd Bombardment Group. SoAL graduate student, **Donna Lucas**, awarded the Learning and Leadership Grant from the National Education Association. MCA students produced a short film for the **Regent's Cup**, a debate tournament sponsored by Chancellor Sonny Perdue and the Board of Regents, English led **internships** with Mercer University Press, the Georgia Writers Museum, Groundwork Resources, LLC, and the Office of Technology Licensing at GA Tech.
