

Using the Prep and Learning Module

What is the ALEKS Prep and Learning Module?

After the non-proctored Initial Assessment, a targeted Prep and Learning Module is available for you to review and learn material to help prepare for the Proctored Assessment.

How does the Prep and Learning Module work?

After you begin the learning module, you will work on increasing your math knowledge until you are satisfied with your progress. Along the way, you will see progress reports that indicate your current knowledge level.

How long do I have access to my Prep and Learning Module?

You will have twelve (12) months of access to your Prep and Learning module. Access to the prep and course will not begin until you select **start** on the top of your screen. DO NOT select into the Prep and Learning Module until you are ready to start working.

Must I work in my ALEKS Prep and Learning Module between Placement Assessments?

You can retake the Placement Assessment up to four (4) additional times in a proctored environment to improve your score. The highest score will be used for math placement. Students are required to work in the Prep and Learning Modules for at least five (5) hours prior to each Placement Assessment to increase success.

What are ALEKS Knowledge Checks?

While working in a Prep and Learning Module, you will periodically complete a Knowledge Check to make sure you have mastered the topics you gained in the Learning Module. If you do not show mastery during the Knowledge Check, the topics will be added back into your learning pie so you can review them again.

Does Progress in an ALEKS Prep and Learning Module count toward placement?

No, you must complete a new proctored placement assessment to change your placement result. Click on the Placement tab on the upper right of the page from within ALEKS. Only your proctored placement assessment results will be used for course placement.

Can I change to a different Prep and Learning Module later?

No, you may only use one Prep and Learning Module. If you are unsure which module to select, consult with your advisor.
